COVID-19 GUIDELINES

The Associated General Contractors of Virginia (AGCVA) values the safety and well-being of its member businesses, their employees, AGCVA's employees, and anyone attending an AGCVA event. AGCVA will follow all venue, state, and local guidance and directives with respect to COVID-19. Understanding the value in-person events have to AGCVA and its members, AGCVA supports holding in-person events that follow necessary safety protocols to ensure the health and well-being of attendees and the local community. This will allow AGCVA to get "Safely Back" to normal operations.

AGCVA asks that anyone not fully vaccinated wear a face covering in accordance with CDC and state guidance. Any individual fully vaccinated may wear a face covering at the individual's discretion. This applies to any AGCVA event and in the AGCVA headquarters office in Richmond.

Further, all attendees to the 2022 AGCVA Convention must show proof of vaccination (not including a booster) OR a negative test in the 48 hours prior to their arrival at the event. This includes registered AGCVA member attendees, family members, and guests.

Proof of vaccination will include: vaccination card, a photo or a copy of your vaccination card, or the Virginia Department of Health QR code including the dates.

Proof of a negative test will include: test results from a lab (either rapid or PCR), a photo of an at-home test, including date and time of test and name of individual.

No vaccination or testing information will be collected. Upon verification of vaccination or negative test results, attendees will be provided with convention registration materials.

Any attendee concerned about his or her health, has a company policy change related to COVID, or other COVID related need may cancel without penalty through Friday, January 14. Any cancellations after January 14 will be handled on a case-by-case basis at the discretion of staff and every effort will be made to consider COVID status.

By attending an AGCVA event, all individuals are asserting that they are not experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or have not recently been exposed to COVID-19.

Further, AGCVA asks any attendee who responds in the affirmative to any question below not attend the event in question.

- Are you currently experiencing any of the following symptoms: new or worsening cough, shortness of breath, fever, or chills?
- In the last 14 days, have you:
 - Had a fever of over 100.4°?
 - Been in contact with anyone who has a medically confirmed positive lab test for COVID-19?
 - Attended an event with a reported COVID-19 outbreak?
 - Traveled to any location which has reported a COVID-19 outbreak?
